SOME GENERAL CLUB RULES AND INFORMATION

(more rules will be discussed at the rider's meeting on Saturday morning at 8:15 a.m.)

- Riding boots or riding shoes required
- Helmets are recommended.
- No clip-on spurs
- No excessive whipping, excessive spurring or striking the animal on the head. Abuse of a horse anywhere on the fairgrounds will not be tolerated
- No horse is allowed to compete against itself in the same age group, but horse may be shared if in different age groups
- At the discretion of the judge, gimmicks will not be allowed
- We do not pre-assign riding partners. We run three lanes, so everyone will need two partners.

FAIRGROUND'S RULES

- No trailers/RVs or non-handicapped vehicles in handicap spots
- No horse trailers in the RV area (unless it's an actual RV)
- **ABSOLUTELY NO HORSES ALLOWED IN THE RV AREA AT ANY TIME!**
- **NO DOGS** allowed inside the fence by the horse barns. Dogs must be on a leash at all times. **If you don't have to bring your dog, we prefer that you don't.** We get a lot of complaints from the fairgrounds about this.
- **NO BICYCLES IN EQUESTRIAN AREA** (ok in parking lot)
- **NO tying horses to trailers.** All horses must be stalled.
- Only one horse per stall.

2ND CHANCE SADDLE CLASS

Have you ever felt like you had your best show and missed winning the saddle?

This year's O-Mok-See will have an additional class with a chance to win a "Second Chance" trophy saddle. For all the contestants who have never won a saddle before, we would like to give you a second chance.

To be eligible – any contestant who has NEVER won a saddle before can enter (\$15 fee) during registration before the show starts. Just like all other jackpots, the rider rides in their age group and no additional runs are made. At the end of the show, all entered contestants times' are calculated and placed in each event just like normal BUT only against the "second chance" contestants. Rider with the most points wins! In the event that the second chance saddle winner also wins the saddle for their age group, the second chance saddle will be given to the rider in second place in second chance saddle class.
